A general guideline regarding the games and limits on most cruises is as follows:

Texas hold'em: \$1-\$2 beginners, \$2-\$4, \$4-\$8, \$10-\$20, \$20-\$40

Omaha/8: \$4-\$8, \$10-\$20, occasionally higher

Mixed games: \$20-\$40, occasionally higher

No-limit hold'em at blinds of \$1-\$2 and \$2-\$5 with capped buy-ins
