

Cozumel, Mexico

Staterooms – Celebrity Solstice

OS - Owner's Suite

Marble entry with doorbell. Queen-size bed, bathroom with tub. Separate living area with a queen-size sofa bed. Up to 4 guests. Stateroom: 596 sq. ft. Balcony: 204 sq. ft.



GS - Grand Suite

Grand Suite w/Balcony (401 sq. ft., balcony 104 sq. ft.) Two twin beds that convert to a Royal King size bed, private balcony, sitting area (some with sofa bed) and private bathroom.



J3 - Junior Suite

Junior Suite Two twin beds that convert to Royal King, private balcony, sitting area (some with sofa bed) and private bathroom. Up to 6 guests. Stateroom: 297 sq. ft. Balcony: 94 sq. ft.



2B - Ocean View Balcony Stateroom

Superior Ocean View Strm w/Bal (199 sq. ft., balcony 65 sq. ft.) Two twin beds that convert to a Royal King size bed, sitting area (some with sofa bed), private balcony and private bathroom. Rates vary from deck to deck.



8N - Ocean View Stateroom

Ocean View Stateroom (159 sq. ft.) Two twin beds that convert to a Royal King size bed and private bathroom.



4V - Inside Stateroom

Interior Stateroom Access Two twin beds that convert to Royal King and private bathroom. Up to 4 guests. Stateroom: 162 sq. ft.



6V - Inside Stateroom

Interior Stateroom (150 sq. ft.) Two twin beds that convert to a Royal King size bed and private bathroom.



Note: A Royal King measures 72.5 inches wide by 82 inches long. All staterooms and suites come complete with private bathroom, vanity area, hair-dryer, closed-circuit TV, radio and phone.
